





From product design to product usage, rvb®'s approach to ecology is simple, consistent and uncompromising.

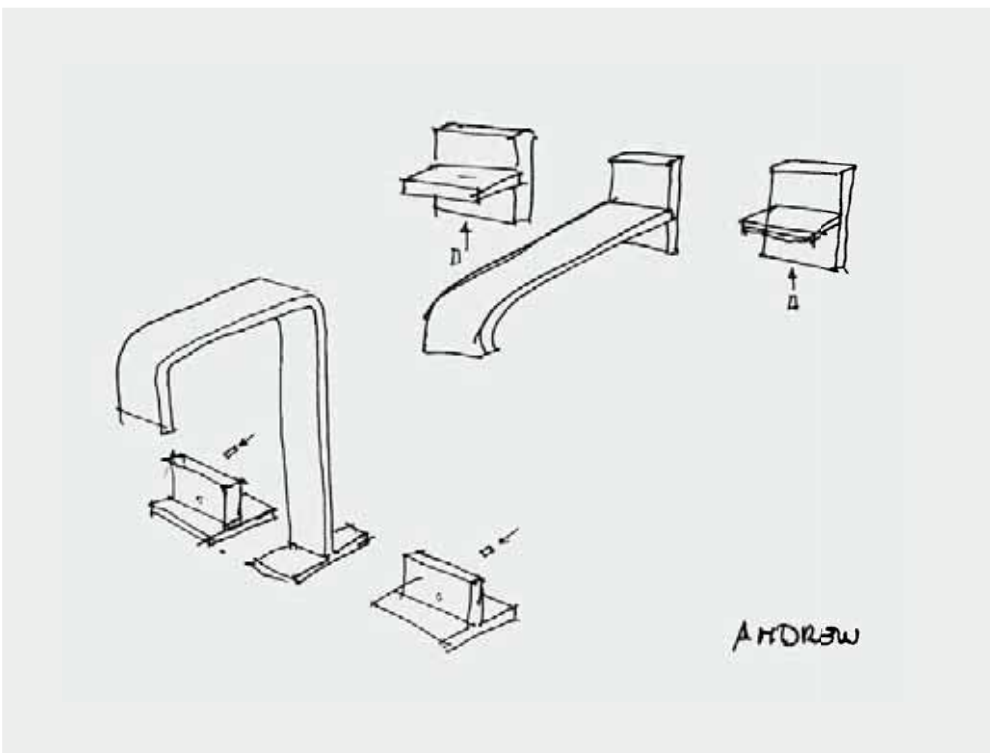


Quality

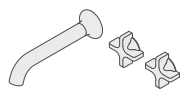
This minimal classic style combines the best of tradition and innovation, a meeting between the past and the future. The simple elegant shapes of the Times models fit both classic and contemporary interiors.

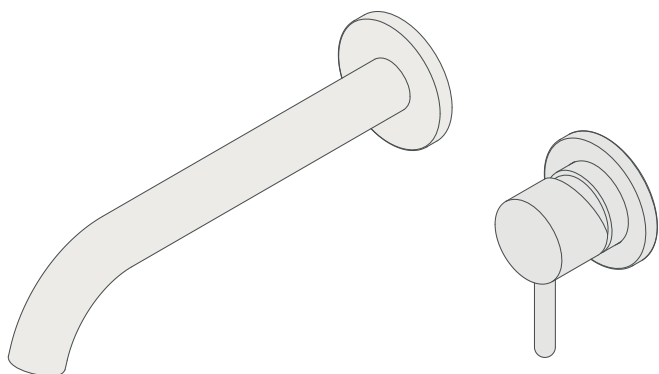

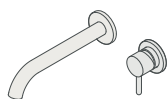

He has since designed many other successful collections including the Tune, which won the Belgian Building Awards Design Award in 2009.
